

Clements Cutting Club Point System

The point system is pretty easy and straight forward. *Every horse in a class gets at least 1 point, with the exception of a 0.* Horses are awarded points according to how many horses are in the class. If there's 7 horses, the first place horse gets 7 points, the 2nd place horse 6, the 3rd place horse 5 and so on, with the exception of 60s. All 60s get 1 point just for coming and showing.

The point system examples are as follows:

5 horses in a class

score:	place:	points:
72	1st	5
71	2nd	4
65	3rd	3
60	4th	1
60	4th	1

Sample: 8 horses in a class (Tie - add placings tied for and divide by number of horses that tied for positions. In this case 2 riders tie for 3rd/4th - 6pts + 5pts = 11 then divide by 2 = 5.5pts each)

8 horses in a class

score:	place:	points:

71	2nd	7
